

Chalk and Wire Faculty Roles and Training Options

What Role Will You Have for Chalk and Wire?

Prior to the Fall 2007 PTEU wide implementation, each program area identified multiple individuals to serve as developers & reporters, power users, or assessors. Each of these roles carries different responsibilities and in some cases different account privileges. When requesting new accounts, please check with your program coordinator to determine which Chalk and Wire Role you will need.

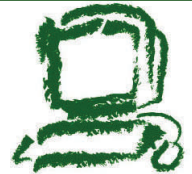
Developers & Reporters – This role typically resides with the program coordinator who is responsible for overseeing the use of Chalk and Wire and for generating data reports for the program area.

Power Users – This role is assigned to program coordinators and/or faculty who will teach courses where Chalk and Wire will be initially taught to students. Power Users can also support other new faculty who need to learn to use Chalk and Wire, and would serve as a contact person for program specific questions about the use of Chalk and Wire.

Assessors – The assessor role is assigned to any faculty member teaching a course that requires assignments to be evaluated in Chalk and Wire using a rubric.

Faculty Training Options

In an effort to meet the diverse learning needs of PTEU faculty, 4 training options are currently available.



Option 1 - Online Learning Modules

These modules serve as guided tutorials that can be completed online at any time. Faculty may review these modules multiple times until they are comfortable with the skills required to assess candidate work within Chalk and Wire. These also serve as good “refresher” updates from semester to semester when faculty may have forgotten a specific step after not using Chalk and Wire for a while. Option 2 - Departmental Group Training Sessions

If you have several new faculty or even several faculty who need to be trained on Chalk and Wire, please feel free to contact the Chalk and Wire Coordinator to schedule a departmental group training session. You may also send an email to chalkandwirehelp@kennesaw.edu to make the request.

Option 3 - Individual Training Sessions

Faculty preferring individual training sessions may contact the Chalk and Wire Coordinator at any time throughout the semester to schedule a time to work 1-on-1 to learn the skills required for assessors. It is expected to take approximately 30-45 minutes to learn this process. You may email chalkandwirehelp@kennesaw.edu to make a request for an individual training session.

Option 4 - Small Group Training Sessions

Small group sessions are scheduled throughout the semester for faculty preferring to attend an informal drop-in session to learn the skills required for assessors or to get any Chalk and Wire questions answered. While these sessions are targeted at assessors, faculty serving in the roles of Power Users and/or Developers & Reporters are welcome to attend if facing specific Chalk and Wire related issues. Dates for the Small Group Sessions are provided in the table below.
