



Master of Education in Adolescent Education

With regard to my graduate work at Kennesaw State University, I understand the following:

The graduate programs in the College of Education at Kennesaw State University, although aligned with the National Board of Professional Teaching Standards, do not require graduates to seek National Board Certification nor guarantee graduates will be board certified if and when they choose to apply for National Board Certification.

The Master of Education in Adolescent Education program at Kennesaw State University does not lead to middle grades certification or certification in a secondary education content area. Individuals wishing to be certified, should contact the Professional Standards Commission directly to obtain information on specific requirements for certification.

The graduate program of study in the Department of Secondary and Middle Grades Education leads to a Master of Education degree in Adolescent Education with a concentration in English/Language Arts, mathematics, science or social studies.

In the accelerated cohort model, candidates can finish in a minimum of 18 months if they continue as full time students as described in the program of study. If candidates do not follow courses of study as outlined, they may not be able to complete the program in 18 months.
