Request for HOPE Scholarship Eligibility Review

Do not submit unless you can answer YES to all of the following:

- 1. Completed GFSAPPS @ www.GAcollge411.org
- 2. Fully accepted into KSU
- 3. Have graduated from an eligible High School with a “B” average, as defined by the HOPE Program, OR have earned at least a 3.0 GPA at the college level at 30, 60 or 90 attempted credit-hour checkpoints.
- 4. KSU Admissions has received and Registrar’s Office has evaluated all final official updated Academic Transcripts.
- 5. Be enrolled as a degree-seeking student as an undergraduate without having received a Bachelors Degree.
- 6. Georgia Resident for at least 24 months.
- 7. U.S. Citizen / Permanent Resident / U.S. National for at least 12 months.
- 8. Be in compliance with Selective Service registration requirements (males).
- 9. Be in compliance with the Georgia Drug-Free Postsecondary Education Act of 1990. A Student is ineligible if he/she has been convicted for committing certain felony offenses involving marijuana, controlled substances, or dangerous drugs.
- 10. Not be in default or owe a refund on a student Financial Aid program.
- 11. Must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress as defined by KSU.
- 12. Have not exceeded 127 attempted hours.

If you meet all the criteria listed above, complete the HOPE Evaluation Request and submit it to the Office of Student Financial Aid.

The processing time is approximately 4 to 6 weeks.

- Note:** * Your HOPE GPA may vary from your academic GPA. The HOPE GPA is calculated based on the total amount of attempted hours at KSU and /or any post secondary institutions attended.
* Please check you Final HOPE Scholar Status and GSFAPP status at www.GAcollge411.org
* While you may have been eligible for the HOPE Grant at a Technical School, this does not automatically qualify you for the HOPE Scholarship. The HOPE Scholarship is based on merit (3.0 cumulative GPA) but the HOPE Grant is not merit based.
