All materials not submitted electronically should be placed together in a packet and submitted by mail or in person at one time. Please leave sealed items in their original envelopes when putting them in the packet.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Online Graduate Application – There is a non-refundable \$60 application fee. www.kennesaw.edu/graduate/admissions/application.html
<input type="checkbox"/>	Transcripts – Official transcripts from EACH College and/or University you have attended. Must be in sealed envelope from the institution. Should reflect a Masters degree with a major in nursing from a nationally accredited institution.
<input type="checkbox"/>	GRE Score Report – Request that your scores be sent electronically to KSU (school code 5359). No department code is necessary. Minimum scores of 500 Verbal, 500 Quantitative and 3.5 Analytic Writing.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Statement of Personal Goals – Can be uploaded into the online application. Should describe your personal and professional interests and goals related to nursing doctoral study (1-2 pages in length).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of Current License to practice nursing in the United States.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Curriculum Vitae or Resume - Can be uploaded into the online application.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Three Letters of Recommendation - Can be sent electronically through the online application.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Course in Statistics (graduate or undergraduate) documented on transcripts. Graduate course in Research documented on transcripts.
