Dictionaries

- The dictionary of anthropology [electronic resource] / edited by Thomas Barfield.
KSU Netlibrary electronic book GN307 .D485 1997
Includes over 500 entries on cultural and social anthropology. Bibliographies of additional readings are at the end of most entries.
- Dictionary of twentieth century culture / edited by Karen L. Rood.
RefStacks GN307 .D35
KSU owns five volumes of this twenty volume set: American Culture after WWII (v.1), African American Culture (v.6), French Culture 1900-1975 (v.9), Hispanic Culture of South America (v.10), and Hispanic Culture of Mexico, Central America, and Caribbean (v.11). Timelines of works and events are included in the beginning of each volume along with references after each entry.

Encyclopedias

- Countries and their cultures / Melvin Ember and Carol R. Ember, editors.
RefStacks GN307 .C68 2001 v.1-v.4 and KSU Netlibrary electronic book
Profiles of 225 countries and their people. Bibliographies are at the end of each entry.
- Encyclopedia of cultural anthropology / editors, David Levinson, Melvin Ember.
RefStacks GN307 .E52 1996
Sponsored by the Human Relations Area Files, offers 340 summaries of contemporary views in the field. Includes a list of anthropological journals.
- Encyclopedia of social and cultural anthropology / edited by Alan Barnard, Jonathan Spencer. RefStacks GN307 .E525 1996 and KSU Netlibrary electronic book
There are 231 entries on important areas of anthropological work. Further readings and cross-references are included. There is also a bibliographical appendix and a glossary of terms.
- A social history of anthropology in the United States [electronic resource] / Thomas C. Patterson. KSU Netlibrary electronic book GN308.3.U6 P38 2001
Covers five eras in US anthropology: in the new republic (1776-1879); in the liberal age (1879-1929); search for social order (1929-1945); postwar (1945-1973); and a neoliberal era (1974-2000)

Handbooks

- Ethnic groups worldwide: a ready reference handbook / by David Levinson.
RefStacks GN325 .L46 1998 and KSU Netlibrary electronic book
Ethnic Group profiles are listed alphabetically under regions of Africa, Americas, Asia/Pacific, and Europe. Lists and descriptions of major ethnic groups and analysis of ethnic relations make up the entries.

Journals - Journals may be found electronically through a database, first floor microfilm room, or third floor bound section. For a list go to the library homepage → Find a Journal → Subject Search (upper right of the page) → Select Anthropology. Here are a few examples:
