

The requirements for the music minor are as follows:

1) Be fully accepted into the music department as a minor by being accepted into KSU, completing a supplemental music application and completing a successful audition for the music faculty.

2) The minor in music is a prescribed area of music studies at the baccalaureate level consisting of eighteen (18) semester hours, ten of which are at the upper division level. Students must earn a grade of "C" in all course work applicable to the music minor. In order to graduate with a minor in music on the student permanent record, the student must complete all requirements and submit to the Registrar's Office a completed and approved "Declaration of Formal Minor" form along with the student's petition to graduate. The Department of Music approves all music minors and advises students as to all specific requirements of the minor.
