

Welcome to the KSU Tennis Complex

The KSU Tennis Complex is funded by Kennesaw State University Tuition and Student Fee money. Therefore, use is restricted to members of the KSU community (Students, Faculty, Staff and Alumni). Proof of Affiliation is required to use the courts. Courts will be patrolled by Student Recreation & Wellness Center Staff.

BE PREPARED TO PRESENT YOUR KSU ID TO A KSU STAFF MEMBER.

Users not able to present proper KSU ID will be asked to leave.

Each KSU user is allowed 1 guest per day; guest should be prepared to sign a liability waiver. Guest must be playing on same court as sponsor.

Tennis Court policies:

- 1) Courts are to be used for tennis only. No bicycles, skateboards, skates, lacrosse, cricket, hockey, or other activities are permitted.
- 2) Proper attire required - players must wear non-marking athletic shoes.
- 3) No tobacco products, food, cans or glass bottles allowed on courts, drinks must be in a closed-top plastic container.
- 4) With the exception of assistance animals, no pets are allowed on courts.
- 5) Private instruction or classes are not permitted without prior written permission by Kennesaw State University.
- 6) During open-play time, courts are available on a first come-first served basis. Courts cannot be held if there are others waiting and ready to play.
- 7) All participants are expected to be courteous to other players and follow standard tennis etiquette at all times.
- 8) Please be respectful of the courts and equipment. No sitting, pushing or pulling of nets is permitted.
- 9) People waiting to play are asked to remain outside the enclosed court area.
- 10) University Administration maintains the right to refuse usage to individuals not complying with the aforementioned rules.

Policies will be enforced by Student Recreation & Wellness Center Staff and KSU Public Safety. Any user in violation of the Court policies will be asked to leave and if necessary referred to KSU Public Safety or the Student Judiciary Program.

Intramural & Recreation Services at Kennesaw State University will monitor the Courts during times of operation, except the times being used by the Varsity Women's Tennis Team. At that time, the tennis coach will be responsible for the supervision of the courts. The Court Supervisor will be responsible for unlocking and locking the entry gate. The Court Supervisor will check all IDs. Through the use of a shift report, all usage counts and problems should be noted and documented. In emergency situations, please locate the Court Supervisor or the Building Manager in the Rec Center to obtain help. The tennis courts may be closed due to weather conditions or holidays. Court conditions and weather conditions will be evaluated on a regular basis. If the court conditions improve, the courts may be reopened. Court information will be posted on the bulletin board located on the fence at Courts 1 & 2.
