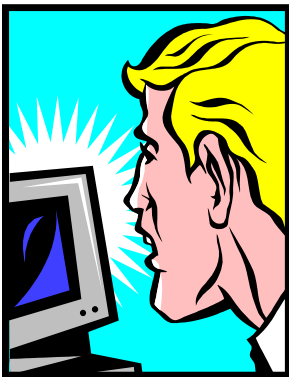

This course will explore how the Internet has changed our lives. Areas including business, medicine, politics, socializing, entertainment, shopping, and education will be examined. We will begin with an introduction to basic technologies that underlie the Internet and the World Wide Web and will consider issues such as privacy, intellectual property, security, and the digital divide. This interdisciplinary course will help students improve their ability to find sources, evaluate the quality of evidence in those sources, and use good evidence effectively in academic writing. Mr. Dewi Wilson, Assistant Librarian in our own Sturgis Library, will take students on both a literal and virtual tour of the library's resources, and Dr. Liza Davis will work with them both in and out of class to fine-tune critical thinking and writing skills. Emphasis will be on what it means to write well in one's specific area of study: students will explore the question "What is the relationship between academic discipline and writing?" in journal entries, brief written exercises, and informal discussion of readings. They will also learn to revise their academic prose for effectiveness and clarity of expression and master the style manuals appropriate to their discipline. There will be no tests or term papers. **Please note: STUDENTS NEED HONORS OFFICE APPROVAL TO REGISTER.**
