- ENGL 1102 Transfer Equivalency and Pre-Requisite Requirements
 - Involves transfer credits from non-USG schools
 - Courses that come in from other schools that transfer in as ENGL 1102
 - o Do students have to take ENGL 1101 (prerequisite) when they come in with ENGL 1102 as transfer?
 - ENGL 1101 teaches fundamental skills that may be needed later

- Possibly have students test out of ENGL 1101 if they choose
- There is a CLEP test for ENGL 1101 with a Composition Module
- Will follow up with Dr. Letizia Guglielmo and Kim West regarding this issue

2:00pm - Credit by Exam and CLEP Test Update

- Very good progress on the new Credit by Exam request form
 - Still on progress to start using the form in August
 - Will have a version of the form for review soon
- Update to CLEP test availability for upper level courses
 - KSU has said we will accept all CLEP tests for which there is a score available
 - Can CLEP tests be applied to upper level courses?
 - Educational psychology and 3000-level marketing and management, for example
 - We reached out to CLEP board
 - We received confirmation that the tests are based on the community college first and second level protocols
 - CLEP test will not be eligible for 3000 level courses
 - Information has been updated on testing site
- Credit by exam site
 - Drop down menu will be available to show which courses have a test available
 - When students register for a test, an automatic handshake with banner will double check their eligibility for testing out of the course
 - A check to ensure they haven't tried testing before, or have sat for the class and failed
 - This will provide clearance at university level
 - Departments can have additional requirements for testing out of courses
 - All exams will be approved by the department prior to allowing a student to sit for the exam
