There is an equivalent course at the undergraduate level. This would be a free elective that would be open to all graduate students. It was asked if these projects are considered graduate level research. It was confirmed that they are, and that it is possible that projects can lead to thesis or dissertation opportunities. Exercise Science, MS – Package #4

Program Change

Cherilyn McLester presented the package. The MS in Applied Exercise and Health Science has a name that does not reflect the current curriculum. Courses related to the health discipline were deactivated several years ago. The package also includes reducing hours from 36 to 30, and removing a Sport Management concentration, which allows the Exercise Physiology concentration to move into a 21 hour core with electives and 3 capstone options. These changes will allow for improved marketability along with providing an accurate degree title. Humayun Zafar motioned to recommend to approve and Sanjeev Adhikari seconded.
