


BFA in Art, Art Education

- **Step 1: Get Admitted**
 - · Apply to KSU & the School of Art and Design.
 - Submit your portfolio: Portfolio Requirements.





- Admission through the Bagwell College of Education (BCOE).
- Requirements:
 - 36 hrs of coursework (ENGL 1101, 1102, EDUC 2110 with "C" or higher).
 - GPA 2.5 or above.
 - Register with GaPSC, create MyPSC account, pass Georgia Educator Ethics (Test 360).



- Obtain GaPSC Pre-Service Certificate.
- Apply via BCOE Teacher Education Policies.

Step 4: Required Courses

Studio Courses (2-D & 3-D):

- ART 3160: Painting I
- ART 3400: Digital Photography
- ART 3500: Printmaking I
- ART 3120: Ceramics I

- ARH 2750: Ancient through Medieval Art
- ARH 2850: Renaissance through Modern Art
- ARH 3850: Art Since 1900
- ARED 3304: Teaching Art History, Criticism, & Aesthetics

Step 5: Field Experience & Student Teaching

- Field placements & Yearlong Clinical Experience (YCE I & II).
- Apply for placements through CEPP.
- Coordinator approval required.

 - Take GACE Art Education Content Exams (#109 & 110).
 - Apply for GaPSC certification and art teaching positions in Georgia.
