

OPEN CALL: ART by P-12 TEACHERS

Invisible to Visible

July 26 - August 26, 2022

Zuckerman Museum of Art, Fine Arts Gallery

The theme for this biennial exhibition is work that makes visible that which was unseen.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Please submit up to 3 works for consideration through the online application portal, <https://ksucollegeofthearts.wufoo.com/forms/invisible-to-visible-art-submission-form/>.
- The deadline for submissions is 5:00 pm, Friday, June 10, 2022.
- You must include high-quality digital representations of your art for consideration. If the file cannot be viewed, your work cannot be judged and will not be considered.
File names should be written in the following convention:
lastname_firstname_shorttitle_imagenumber
Up to two images per 2D work: one full frontal, one detail
Up to three images per 3D work: one full frontal and two of your choice.
For digital work larger than 25 mb (animation, video, etc.) please provide an active link to view your work online.
- If your work is to be hung on a wall, please ensure that it has either two D-rings or a secure wire strung from the back. Sawtooth hangers or other framing hardware are not accepted.
- Works on canvas need not be framed but can be framed, if you would like.
- Works on paper must be mounted or framed, ready to hang.
- If your work is 3D, please ensure that it either has a stable base or can fit on a 1-foot square pedestal. It must be able to fit through a standard doorway.
- If accepted work is to be displayed digitally, you must deliver it on a flash drive. If there are hardware requirements beyond the ZMA's available resources, the work cannot be accepted. Due to space limitations, works larger than 50 inches in any direction cannot be accepted.

INSTALLATION TIMELINE

- You will be notified of acceptance via email on or before Friday, July 1, 2022.
- Delivery of artwork is Saturday, July 23, 10:00 am -5:00 pm. Selected work should be delivered to the Zuckerman Museum's Fine Arts Gallery on the Kennesaw Campus. If your work is not delivered in this time frame, or an alternative agreement arranged with the ZMA staff in advance of this date, it will be rejected from the exhibition.
- Promotion for this show will be a digital invitation, delivered to the accepted artists to share as desired, announcements through the KSU College of the Arts weekly newsletter, announcement on the ZMA website, & social media posts (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter) up to and during the show.

EXHIBITION TIMELINE

- The show opens to the public Tuesday, July 26, 2022.
- The art will be on display through Friday, August 26, 2022. Pick up of artwork is Saturday, August 27, 2022 from 10:00 am -5:00 pm. Due to a lack of storage space, the work cannot be held if you or your proxy do not pick up your work by 5:00 pm on Saturday, August 27, 2022.
