Dear Art Educators of Metro Atlanta:

You are invited to submit art for consideration in *Invisible to Visible*, an upcoming art exhibition to be held in the Zuckerman Museum of Art (ZMA) Fine Arts Gallery at Kennesaw State University, **July 26 – August 26, 2022**. In 2020, the ZMA hosted another exhibition of art for P-12 Art Educators. Following the success of that exhibition, it was determined to make an exhibition for Art Educators a biennial event!

The exhibition will be juried by Al Shockley, an Atlanta based painter, sculptor, and drawer who has been exhibiting artwork in Atlanta and beyond since 1998. Shockley is an Assistant Professor of Art at Georgia State University Perimeter College. They have a B.A in Anthropology from Emory University, a B.F.A from the Atlanta College of Art and an M.F.A from the Savannah College of Art and Design.

The title and theme align with Shockley's philosophy of artmaking, which explores the representation of internal experiences. The exhibition will highlight work that focuses on bringing a unique creative vision to life. The work art educators do to support student development, bringing visibility to young artists who otherwise might not be recognized for their accomplishments and providing opportunity for students to cultivate their creative vision, are other aspects of the theme.
