Responding to our continuous improvement approach, we listened to feedback from our partnering school district and the parents of 2023 participating students.

One major barrier they identified was that the program was only available to 1st and 2nd graders, leaving older siblings at home without access to other camps due to financial and transportation limitations. To address this need, we introduced a 4th-grade class for the first time, specifically inviting upper elementary siblings to participate. This addition proved to be one of the most impactful changes to the program, yielding some of the strongest results. Over 90% of these students spoke little to no English and were struggling in school, feeling isolated, unsupported, and unmotivated. With the guidance of our empathetic preservice teachers, they not only improved their literacy skills but also gained confidence in other academic and social areas, helping them feel more prepared for the upcoming school year.

Thanks to the funding we received, this was the first year we were able to hire such a large group of preservice teachers, creating a profound impact on multiple levels.

Many of our teacher candidates have faced economic and sociocultural barriers themselves, making the opportunity to earn an income while gaining

hands-on experience in their chosen profession truly life-changing. The unique nature of Fast Start, where they serve students in whom they can "recognize themselves," proved both inspiring and cathartic. At the same time, for the elementary students, seeing teachers who looked like them helped foster a sense of safety, understanding, and motivation. Many even expressed a newfound desire to become teachers themselves. As one teacher candidate shared, "Going

through school has always been a struggle for me, making me question every step of the way, but these students changed my life and validated why becoming a teacher is not only a dream but an honor I can't wait to fulfill!"
