# Spring 2024 C-Day Deadlines, Submission Information & Instructions

The Spring 2024 Computing Showcase will be held In-Person on Thursday, April 25th, from 3:30 – 7:30 p.m.

## Please observe these Deadlines/Steps

- First Deadline/Step 1: 5:00 pm on Monday, April 1<sup>st</sup> Students must submit their project information. <u>Instructions are available</u>. No late submissions will be accepted.
  - a. Submissions must include:
    - i. Project Title
    - ii. Project Description
    - iii. Research Question or Motivation
    - iv. Materials and Methods
    - v. Preliminary results
    - vi. Intellectual or business merit of your project (this answer will be used in selecting projects for the event)
    - vii. Actions you will take to enhance the potential of your project to benefit society
- 2. Second Deadline/Step 2:

The departments must submit a ranked list of the projects in each category

- 3. Notification of Acceptance/Step 3: Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup> Students and their advisors will be notified on acceptance
- Final Submission/Step 4: Sunday, April 14<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 p.m. Students submit final documents to be included in C-Day (poster, video, 30 sec video for flash session) by 5:00 p.m. The deadline to upload your C-Day documents is Sunday, April 14<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 p.m.

At least one person completes the form (Microsoft Form TBA) with attendance info & day-of display requirements by Sunday, April 14<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 p.m.

### **Step 4 Documents Required**

Have the following ready prior to starting the process below:

- Project Identifier (Primary Subject Area & Paper ID i.e., GR-104 for Graduate Research paper ID 104)
- Project Description
- Prerecorded presentation file (video mandatory)
- Poster in PDF & PPT format (mandatory)
- 30 sec video for flash presentation (optional)

### Tips for your C-Day poster:

- Please make sure to change "XX-000" on the ppt Template to your Project Identifier & Category that was assigned to you in the acceptance email (i.e., Primary Subject Area & Paper ID i.e., GR-104 for Graduate Research paper ID 104)
- Please make sure that you include the names of all team members and your faculty advisor on the poster
- Please make sure to save the Poster as a pdf file AND as a ppt file

- 5. Upload your 30 sec video for Flash Presentation. Please save the docs as "Flash Project Identifier" (i.e., Flash-GR-104)

#### What is the Flash Presentation?

The Flash Presentation lets you showcase your project to all judges and peers through a 30-second video (or voice over slide). All project videos will be combined and played before judging. Given our tight schedule, the Flash Session guarantees everyone – judges, students, faculty – sees your work. The deadline to submit your 30-sec video for the flash session is Sunday, April 14<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 p.m. While participation in the flash session is not mandatory, it will increase your chance of winning the competition.
