EXPANDING THE NEST

Cultivating Student Success & Recognition Program

As you begin the fall semester, we encourage you to set a goal for which level you hope to achieve this semester with the Expanding the NEST recognition program. There are up to 25 NEST practices those who teach can engage in throughout the semester. Some of the practices would occur in the beginning of the semester (e.g., #3 to develop or cocreate guidelines or community agreements for interaction during class). Take some time during this first week to review the menu of NEST practices and set a goal for which level you aim to achieve from the following:

Eligibility	Faculty/Educators*	Non-Teaching Staff
Champion	25 NEST practices	8 NEST practices
Innovator	15 NEST practices	5 NEST practices
Advocate	6 NEST practices	3 NEST practices

^{*}At least one practice must reflect an institutional initiative

Educators who document the practices they engage will be recognized at our <u>Celebration of Teaching</u>. The questionnaire submission period to be recognized as a NEST Champion, Innovator, and Advocate is October 13 to October 28. The questionnaire will be available on the <u>Expanding the NEST website</u> during that time period.

We hope to see you recognized at the celebration on November 13!

Spotlight on Expanding the NEST

Every month, we will be spotlighting one of the practices for cultivating student success. This is meant to provide tips for implementing the practice.

This month, we are spotlighting:

#25: **Take a deep dive**. Identify one aspect of your course to focus on, contact CETL for support, and make an informed decision for improvement (e.g., identifying the need, collecting data, designing interventions, <u>creating a Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) study</u> for eventual publication, involving students as partners in this work).

The beginning of the semester can provide a great start to taking a deep dive. CETL provides a number of services to assist you in this effort. First, you will need to identify what aspect of your course you want to focus on. This may be a particular assignment or an in-class activity. Then, you will contact CETL for support. If you know you are interested in conducting a SoTL study, you should request a <u>SoTL consultation</u>. If you are more interested in improving an assignment or your course design, you should request a <u>Teaching and Learning Consultation</u>.




SoTL Spotlight




