



STUDY ABROAD OPPORTUNITY

Interested in international entrepreneurship and study abroad? Consider participating in the Experiential Entrepreneurship Study Abroad program in Italy this summer May 26-July 1, 2023. This is a great opportunity to complete a certificate in entrepreneurship to add to your resume, while experiencing entrepreneurship in a different culture. There are only a couple of spots left in the program, and the program is first-come, first-served based on applications and paying the \$300 non-refundable deposit. The final deadline for applying is February 15, 2023. Once the spots fill up, you can add yourself to the waitlist. Apply soon to reserve your spot!

The price for the 5-week program has just been reduced to \$3600 (excluding airfare). The prerequisite for the program is completion of ENTR3001 Entrepreneurial Thinking, which will be offered online during Maymester 2023 for any students who still need it. The study abroad program is open to all students who have completed the prerequisites (not just Coles students), so share the word with your friends!
