

Building Reports for Instructors

You can access your Course Evaluations & Surveys account in two ways:

1. Log in to **Watermark Navigator** and select **Course Evaluations and Surveys**.
2. Clicking on the link in an email sent by the main administrator.

Once you see the Course Evaluations & Surveys site, click on the “Results” tab. This will present a list of dropdown reporting menu options (not all may be enabled)

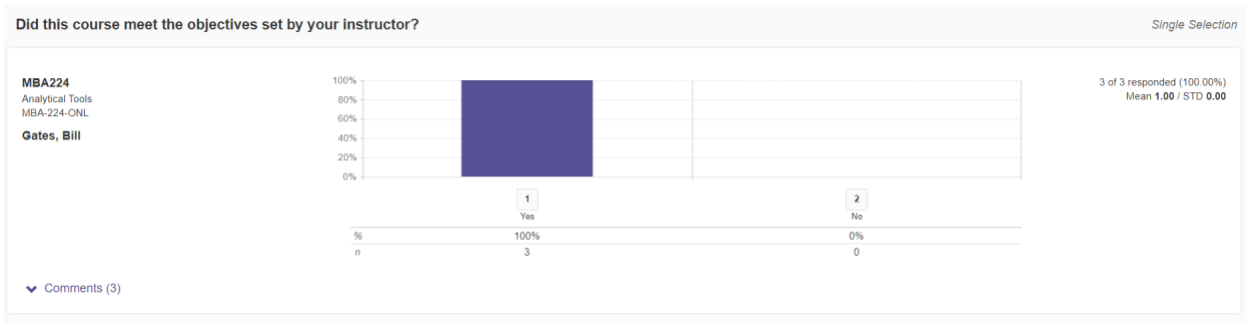

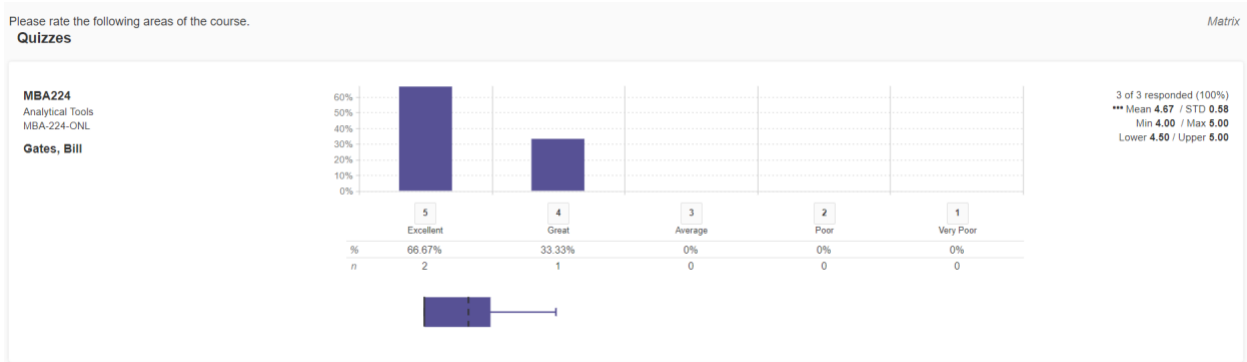
Report Builder
