SW 7704: Human Behavior in a Social Environment I (3 credit hours)

SW 7706: Introduction to Social Work Research (3 credit hours)

SW 7000-level coursework will be used to satisfy first-year MSW requirements, and may be used toward the Upper-Division Elective requirements in the BS in PSYC degree program.
