

KSU Air Quality Permit requires us to verify that all diesel fuel used on campus has a maximum sulfur content of 15 ppm (0.0015% by weight) and a minimum CETANE Index of 40 or maximum aromatic content of 35%. The permit also requires the university to maintain records of the operating hours and fuel usage of generators. To meet these requirements owners of portable generators must certify that the fuel used on the generator (if diesel) meets these conditions and maintain operating records of the generator.

This form, therefore, shall be completed and signed by the owner/operator for each portable generator brought on campus.
