1. Policy Purpose Statement

This policy outlines the use of amplified sound on outdoor University property. Requirements have been established to ensure that amplified sound associated with events held on Kennesaw State University (KSU) property are not disruptive to campus operations.

2. Background

KSU is committed to fostering a vibrant campus community, including the oversight of on-campus space use. The Outdoor Amplified Sound Policy ensures all entities have the ability to contribute to an active and lively campus environment.

3. Scope (Who is Affected)

This policy affects all KSU students, student organizations, employees, and University guests (non-campus members).

4. Exclusions or Exceptions

This policy does not apply to the following:

- A University-sponsored event, for which use of amplified sound on outdoor KSU property is managed by the Department of Event and Venue Management
- KSU Sports and Entertainment Park, Baseball, and Soccer Fields

 Campus Residential Communities, where use of amplified sound is governed by the Residential Codes of Conduct

5. Definitions and Acronyms

Amplified Sound: Any sound whose volume is increased through amplification equipment (audio/visual [A/V] equipment). A/V equipment are devices powered by electronic, mechanical, instrumental, or motor-powered means.

University Property: Land or buildings owned, leased, or used by Kennesaw State University.

Simple Information Table: A simple information table consists of 1 table and 2 chairs only. No additional items can be added when reserving an information table. Information tables can only be reserved for KSU departments or KSU Registered Student Organizations.

6. Policy

Use of amplified sound on outdoor University property is subject to reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions.

Use of amplified sound on outdoor University property requires advanced approval as follows:

- Public forum requesters seeking to use amplified sound must submit a Public Forum Reservation Request Form (https://publicforum.kennesaw.edu/).
- KSU students and employees seeking to host an event with sound amplification on outdoor University property must submit a request through the "Internal Event Request Form" in the KSU Reservations Portal (https://reservations.kennesaw.edu/).

Amplified sound will not be permitted where it disrupts University operations, including classes, University activities with existing confirmed reservations in adjacent locations, and/or other academic and administrative functions of the institution.

Amplified sound is not permitted at Simple Information Tables.

Amplified sound is <u>not</u> permitted during the Finals Period of each semester.

Amplified sound on outdoor University Property may be approved only for the following timeframes and locations during the semester:

Monday-Friday: 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM; 4:00 PM - 11:00 PM

Saturday-Sunday: 11:30 AM - 11:00 PM

10. Violations

Student Organizations: Student organizations found in violation of this policy are subject to loss of reservation access, per the *Registered Student Organization Manual* (Chapter 4, Article I). This process is overseen by the Department of Student Activities.

External Guests: Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of the privilege of using the licensed facilities or termination of the revocable license agreement, as well as other damages allowed under applicable law. This process is overseen by the Department of Event and Venue Management.

Public Forum Requesters: Failure to comply with this policy may result in loss of future access to University property. This process is overseen by the Office of the Dean of Students in consultation with the Office of Legal Affairs.
