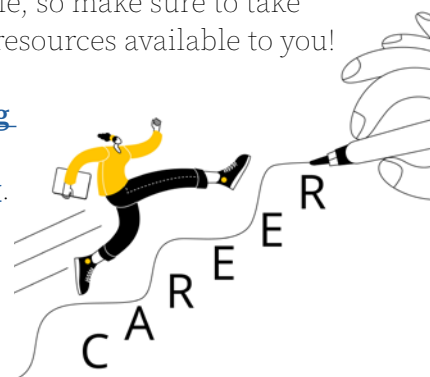
Graduate-Only Evening Career Advising

Learn About Your Body Composition, Bone Density, and Cardiometabolic Risk by Participating in a Research Study



The Department of Exercise Science and Sport Management is continuing to enroll women 60 years and older, and men 20 years and older, into a National Institutes of Health/National Institute on Aging (NIH/NIA) grant-funded research study (NIH #R15AG081856-01A1) to examine

the relationships among daily step counts, body weight/composition, and cardiometabolic risk factors like blood glucose, insulin, and cholesterol levels.

Participants must be healthy and not currently engaged in structured exercise (regular walkers are welcome!). Participants will receive a pedometer (\$25 value), free body composition/bone mineral density testing, and up to \$40 in gift cards in return for completing the study.
