

Apply to KSU's School of Communication & Media

KSU's School of Communication & Media offers you an opportunity to earn a degree in **Journalism & Emerging Media (JOUR)**, **Media & Entertainment (MENT)**, **Organizational & Professional Communication (ORGC)**, and **Public Relations (PR)** at the undergraduate level. Minors in Organizational & Professional Communication, Public Relations and Crisis Preparedness are available to non-SOCM majors.

If you indicated interest in declaring your major but have not yet met the requirements, please declare as one of the following:

- **Journalism & Emerging Media-Interest**
- **Media & Entertainment Studies-Interest**
- **Organizational & Professional Communication - Interest**
- **Public Relations-Interest**

You will be able to declare this through your Owl Express account.

To apply as a JOUR, MENT, ORGC or PR major, you must meet the following criteria:

- Earn an adjusted GPA of 2.75 or higher (an average of your GPA scores) in the following five courses:
 - COMM 1110 Public Speaking
 - COMM 2020 CSI: COM Sources & Investigations
 - COMM 2033 Visual Communication
 - COMM 2135 Writing for Public Communication
 - COMM 2240 Communication Law, Ethics and Diversity

IMPORTANT: These criteria apply for students under the 2023-2024 academic calendar and beyond. Students under older catalogs may be expected to meet different requirements. Please talk to your advisor to confirm your academic plan. All SOCM-Interest and official SOCM majors must earn a grade of "C" or better in all communication courses counted toward their degree.

As you plan your academic program, remember:
