

# Calculating Your Psychology GPA

1. Consider ONLY psychology courses (PSYC prefix).
2. Assign the corresponding quality points (QP) below to each of your letter grades:

Letter Grade	A	B	C	D	F
Quality Point (QP)	4	3	2	1	0

3. Multiply the quality points by the number of credit hours for each course (Credit Hrs x Quality Pts).
4. Sum those numbers. That is, add the numbers in the (Credit Hrs x Quality Pts) column.
5. Divide the sum of these numbers by the total number of PSYC credit hours overall.

**Please see example below...**

Course	Credit Hrs	Quality Pts	Credit Hrs x Quality Pts
PSYC 1101	3	A (4)	12
PSYC 2500	3	C (2)	6
PSYC 3000	3	A (4)	12
PSYC 4100	3	B (3)	9
PSYC 4400	2	A (4)	8
PSYC 4410	3	C (2)	6
PSYC 3355	3	A (4)	12
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>20</b>	--	<b>65</b>

**This student's Psychology GPA =  $65/20 = 3.25$**
