- Discuss potential impact on knowledge, artistic practice, curriculum, or professional development
- Highlight innovative methods, approaches, or contributions
- Explain alignment with the goals of the Creative Scholarship Award and Radow College's mission

3. Objectives

- State specific objectives for your project (what you plan to achieve and why)

4. Project Methods and Plan

- Outline your approach: steps, activities, or process

- Describe roles of any collaborators, students, or community partners
- Timeline for key activities

IV. Budget and Justification

- Attach a basic budget table (see sample below or provide Excel attachment if needed)
- For each item, provide a brief rationale for how it supports project aims
