In an effort to further enhance KSU students' intercultural awareness and create a level of enthusiasm, in October of 2015, the first K-Pop Festival was held in Social Sciences Film Room, which was a huge success with more than 100 KSU students attended, and it has been held annually and has become one of the most popular events at KSU since its inaugural event in 2015. K-Pop Festival featuring K-Pop music, dance, a quiz bowl, and Korean food has successfully accomplished its goal of promoting and raising visibility of the Korean Program at KSU. Despite its short history, the K-Pop Club has been successfully accomplishing its mission and growing vigorously and complements the growth of the Korean Program at KSU that started in 2013 and has been thriving in the face of challenges that have daunted most other foreign language programs.

Unfortunately, the event has been on hold since the 5th K-Pop Festival in November of 2019, where more than 300 students gathered, due to the global outbreak of COVID-19. The K-Pop Club at KSU is willing to outreach our service and expertise and resume this annual capstone event in collaboration with the other two RSOs, K-Pop Dance Club and Korean Language & Culture Club, to support KSU's goals of fostering a welcoming, diverse and inclusive environment and achieving engaged citizenship, global understanding, and appreciation of cultural diversity by infusing multicultural, global perspectives. Not only is this an event for our Club, associated Programs, or KSU, but it is also a chance to collaborate with community partners (including the Consulate General of the Republic of Korea in Atlanta, the Korean Education Center, and local businesses).

Despite its huge success, the participants of the past events have always suggested that we need to provide them with both prizes and Korean food. In order to continue our progress and success in the event, we try to secure funding for Korean sample foods through SABAC. The K-Pop Club will reach out to the community partners mentioned above in an effort to fundraise and garner support for this event.

K-Pop Festival has indeed been a showcase and a great opportunity to foster cultural understanding among KSU students, and we'd like to continue our mission of promoting the Korean language and culture and inclusion of all peoples and diversity on campus through this innovative event.
