Kennesaw State University would be viewed on a national level as having a robust and competitive music community and an exceeding music program. The KSU Trumpet Ensemble will be flying from Hartsfield Jackson (Atlanta, GA) to Corpus Christi International Airport (Corpus Christi, TX). From the Corpus Christi airport, we will rent two sedans (one mini-van was not big enough for 6 personnel, luggage, and instrument storage), and drive the ~40 minute travel time to Kingsville, TX. The National Trumpet Competition is from the 9-11 (all-day) to include solo, small ensemble, large ensemble, semi-finals, and finals. This is where we will compete. On the morning of March the 12th, the KSU Trumpet Ensemble will travel back to the Corpus Christi International Airport, return the van, and fly back to Hartsfield Jackson (Atlanta, GA). End of trip.
