Services include:.

- Academic and Professional Development Workshop Series: Providing students with strategies on improving their study and time management skills, economic mobility, and engagement with the KSU campus and peers.
- Cultural and Education Abroad Enrichment Activities: Providing exposure to new cultural experiences is key to a broaden students' worldview. As available, stipends will be awarded to students to support their Education Aboard travels.
- Near Peer Mentoring: Over the first year, ASCEND's current students or recent graduates will be available to offer firsthand insight and advice to newly enrolled ASCEND scholars.
- Case Management: Together, the student and case manager will develop an individualized plan intended to empower the student to work towards their daily living needs.



ASCEND BRIDGE WEEK

To qualify for the ASCEND program, a person must be a KSU students pursuing their first bachelor's degree and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Unaccompanied Homeless Youth status based upon the McKinney-Vento Act1
- Verified as a Runaway Homeless Youth, defined as a youth "who is not more than 21 years of age...for whom it is not possible to live in a safe environment with a relative and who have no other safe alternative living arrangement." 2
- At any time since turning age 13, both parents deceased, in foster care, or a dependent or ward of the court.3
