



Economic Advantage for US Citizens and Eligible Non-US Citizens Out of State Tuition Differential Waiver

As of the first day of classes for the term, an economic advantage waiver may be granted to a dependent or independent student who can provide clear evidence that the student, the student's parent/U.S. court-appointed guardian, or spouse has relocated to the State of Georgia to accept full-time, self-sustaining employment and has established domicile in the State of Georgia. Relocation to the state must be for reasons other than enrolling in an institution of higher education. The employee upon which the waiver is based upon must hold employment at the same place when the waiver is awarded. This waiver will expire 12 months from the term the waiver was granted. An affected student must petition to change tuition classification after 12 months and must provide additional documentation according to established procedures at Kennesaw State University.

Students will have until 30 days after the first day of the term to apply for this waiver. No applications will be accepted past that date. No retroactive changes will be considered for prior terms or fiscal years.

Please attach copies of the following as it pertains to the person employed full-time:

- Letter from the employer verifying a full-time job was offered to the employee prior to moving to Georgia, the date the job was offered, the date the employee started the job, and employee's address.
- A recent paystub from within the last 30 days.
- Evidence of domicile in Georgia by submitting one of the following:
 - Copy of lease agreement
 - Utility or mortgage bill
 - Warranty deed
 - If your name is not on the lease/warranty deed, provide a notarized statement from home owner stating the date you moved in and the address(es) you have live(d) at with them
 - Copy of your Georgia tax return for the most recent tax year
 - Georgia license or Georgia State ID card

Lawful Presence Verification for the Student: Copy of one of the following:

US Citizen documents:

- Georgia license or State ID (front & back)
- US Passport
- US Certificate of Citizenship/Naturalization
- US Birth Certificate (the seal must be visible and legible)

Non US Citizen documents:

- Permanent Resident Card (front & back)
- Immigration documents (including Passport, Visa, and/or I-94)
- Permanent Resident Card (front & back)
- Employment Authorization Card (front & back)

Provide the following as it pertains to the student if they are a spouse/dependent of the full time employee:

Proof of relationship to full time employee; choose one:

- Birth certificate
- Marriage certificate
- Copy of passport showing relationship between the student and full time employee
- US court documents of legal guardianship
- Certified or Notarized copy of Georgia tax return or Federal tax return

I understand that any material false statement made knowingly and willingly by me on this application, or any documents attached hereto may, in accordance with O.C.G.A. 16-10-71, which provides that upon conviction, a person who knowingly commits the offense of false swearing shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years, or both, subject me to prosecution in a court of law. Additionally, I further understand that any such false statement may subject me to immediate dismissal from the institution.

I understand that I must notify Kennesaw State University immediately if my parent/guardian or spouse is assigned employment outside the State of Georgia. I also understand this waiver, if approved, is valid for 12 months and I must submit a Petition for Georgia Residency once this waiver expires.
