Additionally, I teach upper level courses within the HPE Coaching Minor Program.

During my tenure as coordinator I lead the development of the curriculum, recruitment of faculty, promotion of the program, and oversaw the growth from 30 majors in 1998 to over 400 majors in 2012. Additionally, I provided the leadership to gain NASSM-NASPE program-approval, which at the time (2007), made KSU one of 40 programs in within the United States to achieve this recognition. Furthermore, this program not only developed an excellent reputation within the greater Atlanta community, but it was also highly-reputed on a regional and national basis.

Within this role, I also: Provided leadership for Assurance of Learning and SACS accreditation; served as Field Experiences Coordinator for the Sport Management Major (1996-2013), overseeing all practica and internship experiences for the major that includes over 400 majors and developed significant partnerships with sport organization throughout Atlanta, including the Atlanta Braves, Atlanta Falcons, and Atlanta Hawks Professional Teams as well the Southern Section of the United States Tennis Association; taught undergraduate, upper-division Sport Management courses entitled, "Leadership and Management in Sport Organizations," "Sport Facility Design and Management," and "Senior Sport Management Seminar."
